LOGICAL FALLACIES AND RHETORICAL APPEALS

IT CALLS FOR LEADERS WHO ARE NOT ONLY PRAGMATIC BUT ALSO DEEPLY COMPASSIONATE AND COMMITTED TO THE WELFARE OF ALL MEMBERS OF SOCIETY.
