DO ELEPHANTS KNOW HOW TO GAMBLE IS A CURIOUS QUESTION THAT TOUCHES ON THE INTELLIGENCE, BEHAVIOR, AND COGNITIVE ABILITIES OF THESE MAGNIFICENT CREATURES.
