ORIGINS AND CAUSES OF THE RENAISSANCE

THE RENAISSANCE BEGAN IN ITALY DURING THE LATE 14TH CENTURY AND GRADUALLY SPREAD ACROSS EUROPE. SEVERAL FACTORS CONTRIBUTED TO THE EMERGENCE OF THIS PIVOTAL ERA. REDISCOVERY OF CLASSICAL ANTIQUITY
