UNDERSTANDING THE PURPOSE OF FARM SWAP STUDENT WORKSHEET PART A

THE PRIMARY PURPOSE OF THE FARM SWAP STUDENT WORKSHEET PART A IS TO INTRODUCE STUDENTS TO THE FUNDAMENTAL CONCEPTS OF FARMING AND AGRICULTURE THROUGH A STRUCTURED, INTERACTIVE FORMAT. PROMOTING AGRICULTURAL LITERACY

QUESTION TYPES

THESE INCLUDE MULTIPLE-CHOICE QUESTIONS, MATCHING EXERCISES, SHORT ANSWER RESPONSES, AND FILL-IN-THE-BLANK ACTIVITIES.
