## HISTORY AND ORIGINS OF FARSI DASTAN

### KHOSROW AND SHIRIN BY NIZAMI

NIZAMI'S ROMANTIC EPIC *KHOSROW AND SHIRIN* IS A CELEBRATED EXAMPLE OF FARSI DASTAN FOCUSED ON LOVE AND TRAGEDY. THE STORY OF THE SASSANIAN KING KHOSROW AND HIS BELOVED SHIRIN COMBINES LYRICAL POETRY WITH DEEP EMOTIONAL

EXPRESSION, ILLUSTRATING THEMES OF DEVOTION AND FATE.
