ATTENTION TO LOGICAL COHERENCE, PROPER CITATION, AND ACADEMIC WRITING STYLE IS CRUCIAL. MANUSCRIPTS SHOULD ALSO SITUATE THEIR CONTRIBUTIONS WITHIN EXISTING LITERATURE TO DEMONSTRATE RELEVANCE AND SCHOLARLY ENGAGEMENT.

SUBMISSION PROCESS AND TIMELINE

- INSUFFICIENT ENGAGEMENT WITH RELEVANT LITERATURE

- FAILURE TO ADHERE TO SUBMISSION GUIDELINES
- ETHICAL CONCERNS SUCH AS PLAGIARISM OR CONFLICTS OF INTEREST
