UNDERSTANDING KANNADAKAMA KATHEGALU

KANNADAKAMA KATHEGALU REFERS TO THE TRADITIONAL STORIES AND NARRATIVES THAT ORIGINATE FROM THE KANNADA-SPEAKING REGIONS OF INDIA. THESE STORIES ARE AN INTEGRAL PART OF KARNATAKA'S ORAL AND WRITTEN HERITAGE, REFLECTING THE SOCIAL, CULTURAL, AND SPIRITUAL FABRIC OF THE COMMUNITY. THE TERM "KANNADAKAMA" CAN BE BROKEN DOWN TO RELATE TO KANNADA LANGUAGE AND FOLKLORE, WHILE "KATHEGALU" MEANS STORIES. TOGETHER, THEY ENCOMPASS A WIDE RANGE OF STORYTELLING FORMS, FROM ANCIENT EPICS TO LOCAL FOLKLORE, THAT HAVE SHAPED KANNADA LITERATURE AND CULTURE.

HISTORICAL BACKGROUND

THE HISTORY OF KANNADAKAMA KATHEGALU DATES BACK TO ANCIENT TIMES, WITH ROOTS IN CLASSICAL KANNADA LITERATURE AND FOLK TRADITIONS. Mythological Stories
