CENTRAL AMERICAN VARIATIONS

IN COUNTRIES LIKE GUATEMALA AND EL SALVADOR, LA LLORONA IS SOMETIMES PORTRAYED AS A GHOST WHO KIDNAPS CHILDREN OR LURES THEM TO THEIR DEATH.
