SUMMARY OF MACBETH ACT 2

CHARACTER ANALYSIS IN ACT 2

LADY MACBETH

LADY MACBETH EXHIBITS STRENGTH AND CONTROL, CONTRASTING WITH MACBETH'S TURMOIL. SHE ORCHESTRATES THE PLAN TO KILL DUNCAN AND ENCOURAGES MACBETH TO FOLLOW THROUGH WITH THE DEED. HER MANIPULATION AND RESOLVE ARE EVIDENT AS SHE TAKES CHARGE OF FRAMING DUNCAN'S GUARDS AND CALMING MACBETH'S FEARS, ALTHOUGH SUBTLE HINTS OF

HER OWN INTERNAL STRUGGLE BEGIN TO EMERGE.

OTHER CHARACTERS

SECONDARY CHARACTERS SUCH AS BANQUO, FLEANCE, AND MACDUFF PROVIDE COUNTERPOINTS TO MACBETH'S ACTIONS. BANQUO'S SUSPICION AND MACDUFF'S LOYALTY TO THE RIGHTFUL KING HIGHLIGHT THE GROWING TENSIONS WITHIN THE KINGDOM AFTER DUNCAN'S MURDER.

THEMES AND MOTIFS IN ACT 2

ACT 2 INTENSIFIES SEVERAL THEMES THAT ARE CENTRAL TO THE MACBETH ACT 2 STUDY GUIDE, INCLUDING AMBITION, GUILT, AND THE SUPERNATURAL. THESE THEMES ARE INTRICATELY WOVEN INTO THE DIALOGUE AND ACTION, REINFORCING THE MORAL AND PSYCHOLOGICAL COMPLEXITY OF THE PLAY.
