BEHAVIORAL AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS

CHARACTERISTICS SUCH AS SUBSTANCE ABUSE, MENTAL HEALTH STATUS, EMPLOYMENT HISTORY, AND EDUCATIONAL BACKGROUND ARE ASSESSED. ISSUES LIKE DRUG DEPENDENCY OR UNSTABLE EMPLOYMENT OFTEN CORRELATE WITH HIGHER RISK LEVELS.

SOCIAL AND ENVIRONMENTAL FACTORS

THE TEST ALSO CONSIDERS THE INDIVIDUAL'S LIVING SITUATION, FAMILY SUPPORT, PEER ASSOCIATIONS, AND COMMUNITY TIES. STRONG POSITIVE SOCIAL SUPPORT CAN REDUCE RISK, WHEREAS ASSOCIATIONS WITH CRIMINAL PEERS OR UNSTABLE HOUSING MAY ELEVATE IT.

TYPES OF PROBATION RISK ASSESSMENT TOOLS

RISK ASSESSMENTS IDENTIFY SPECIFIC CRIMINOGENIC NEEDS, ALLOWING FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF PERSONALIZED REHABILITATION PROGRAMS THAT ADDRESS UNDERLYING CAUSES OF CRIMINAL BEHAVIOR.

CONSISTENCY AND OBJECTIVITY

POTENTIAL FOR BIAS
