## SEGREGATION AND JIM CROW LAWS

JIM CROW LAWS ENFORCED RACIAL SEGREGATION IN PUBLIC FACILITIES, SCHOOLS, TRANSPORTATION, AND VOTING RESTRICTIONS, EFFECTIVELY DENYING AFRICAN AMERICANS THEIR CONSTITUTIONAL RIGHTS. THESE LAWS INSTITUTIONALIZED DISCRIMINATION AND CREATED A SOCIAL ORDER BASED ON RACIAL INEQUALITY THAT PERSISTED WELL INTO THE 20TH CENTURY.

## EARLY LEGAL CHALLENGES

ORGANIZATIONS SUCH AS THE NAACP BEGAN MOUNTING LEGAL CHALLENGES TO SEGREGATION AND DISENFRANCHISEMENT IN THE EARLY 1900S. CASES LIKE *BUCHANAN V. WARLEY* (1917) AND *MISSOURI EX REL. GAINES V. CANADA* (1938) SET IMPORTANT PRECEDENTS BY CHALLENGING DISCRIMINATORY PRACTICES IN HOUSING AND EDUCATION.

# LANDMARK SUPREME COURT CASES

AN INTEGRAL COMPONENT OF THE ROAD TO CIVIL RIGHTS ANSWER KEY INVOLVES UNDERSTANDING THE LANDMARK SUPREME COURT DECISIONS THAT DISMANTLED LEGAL SEGREGATION AND EXPANDED CIVIL RIGHTS PROTECTIONS. ## PLESSY V. FERGUSON (1896)

PLESSY V. FERGUSON WAS A PIVOTAL CASE THAT UPHELD RACIAL SEGREGATION UNDER THE "SEPARATE BUT EQUAL" DOCTRINE, GIVING LEGAL SANCTION TO SEGREGATION FOR DECADES. UNDERSTANDING THIS CASE IS ESSENTIAL TO COMPREHENDING THE CHALLENGES CIVIL RIGHTS ACTIVISTS FACED IN OVERTURNING INSTITUTIONALIZED DISCRIMINATION.

## OTHER NOTABLE CASES

- **SMITH V. ALLWRIGHT (1944):** ENDED THE USE OF WHITE PRIMARIES, ALLOWING AFRICAN AMERICANS TO VOTE IN PRIMARY ELECTIONS.
- **HEART OF ATLANTA MOTEL V. UNITED STATES (1964):** SUPPORTED THE CIVIL RIGHTS ACT BY PROHIBITING RACIAL DISCRIMINATION IN PUBLIC ACCOMMODATIONS.
- **LOVING V. VIRGINIA (1967):** INVALIDATED LAWS PROHIBITING INTERRACIAL MARRIAGE.

## KEY CIVIL RIGHTS LEGISLATION

THIS LANDMARK LEGISLATION OUTLAWED DISCRIMINATION BASED ON RACE, COLOR, RELIGION, SEX, OR NATIONAL ORIGIN. IT ENDED SEGREGATION IN PUBLIC PLACES AND BANNED EMPLOYMENT DISCRIMINATION, REPRESENTING A MAJOR VICTORY FOR CIVIL RIGHTS ACTIVISTS AND FUNDAMENTALLY CHANGING AMERICAN SOCIETY.

## VOTING RIGHTS ACT OF 1965

THE VOTING RIGHTS ACT AIMED TO ELIMINATE BARRIERS SUCH AS LITERACY TESTS AND POLL TAXES THAT PREVENTED AFRICAN AMERICANS FROM EXERCISING THEIR RIGHT TO VOTE. THIS ACT SIGNIFICANTLY INCREASED VOTER REGISTRATION AND PARTICIPATION AMONG MINORITY GROUPS, PARTICULARLY IN THE SOUTH.

## OTHER IMPORTANT LEGISLATION

- **FAIR HOUSING ACT (1968):** PROHIBITED DISCRIMINATION IN HOUSING BASED ON RACE, RELIGION, OR NATIONAL ORIGIN.

ADVOCATING NONVIOLENT RESISTANCE AND CIVIL DISOBEDIENCE, KING'S LEADERSHIP IN EVENTS SUCH AS THE MONTGOMERY BUS BOYCOTT AND THE MARCH ON WASHINGTON HELPED ADVANCE CIVIL RIGHTS LEGISLATION AND FOSTERED NATIONAL AWARENESS OF RACIAL INJUSTICE.

### ROSA PARKS

ROSA PARKS' REFUSAL TO GIVE UP HER BUS SEAT TO A WHITE PASSENGER IN MONTGOMERY, ALABAMA, SPARKED THE MONTGOMERY BUS BOYCOTT, A PIVOTAL EVENT IN THE CIVIL RIGHTS MOVEMENT. HER ACT OF DEFIANCE HIGHLIGHTED THE POWER OF INDIVIDUAL COURAGE IN CHALLENGING SYSTEMIC OPPRESSION.

## OTHER KEY ACTIVISTS

- **THURGOOD MARSHALL:** NAACP LAWYER AND THE FIRST AFRICAN AMERICAN SUPREME COURT JUSTICE.
- **MALCOLM X:** PROMINENT ADVOCATE FOR BLACK EMPOWERMENT AND SELF-DEFENSE.
- **JOHN LEWIS:** LEADER IN THE STUDENT NONVIOLENT COORDINATING COMMITTEE (SNCC) AND A KEY FIGURE IN VOTING RIGHTS ACTIVISM.

## MAJOR CIVIL RIGHTS PROTESTS AND EVENTS

THIS 381-DAY BOYCOTT PROTESTED RACIAL SEGREGATION ON PUBLIC BUSES IN MONTGOMERY, ALABAMA. IT SUCCEEDED IN DESEGREGATING THE CITY'S BUSES AND SERVED AS A MODEL FOR NONVIOLENT PROTEST NATIONWIDE.

## MARCH ON WASHINGTON (1963)

THE MARCH ON WASHINGTON FOR JOBS AND FREEDOM DREW OVER 200,000 PARTICIPANTS DEMANDING CIVIL AND ECONOMIC RIGHTS. MARTIN LUTHER KING JR.'S "I HAVE A DREAM" SPEECH AT THIS EVENT BECAME A DEFINING MOMENT IN THE MOVEMENT.

## SELMA TO MONTGOMERY MARCHES (1965)

THESE MARCHES HIGHLIGHTED THE STRUGGLE FOR VOTING RIGHTS AND DREW NATIONAL ATTENTION TO THE VIOLENT RESISTANCE FACED BY CIVIL RIGHTS ACTIVISTS. THE EVENTS HELPED CATALYZE THE PASSAGE OF THE VOTING RIGHTS ACT OF 1965.

## IMPACT AND LEGACY OF THE CIVIL RIGHTS MOVEMENT
