SHE FOLLOWS THROUGH WITH THE PLAN BY TAKING THE POTION, SETTING IN MOTION THE TRAGIC EVENTS THAT FOLLOW. THE SCENE HIGHLIGHTS THE CONTRAST BETWEEN JULIET'S OUTWARD COMPLIANCE AND HER INNER RESOLVE.

SCENE 3: JULIET TAKES THE POTION
