THE COMPROMISE OF 1850 AND THE FUGITIVE SLAVE ACT

THE COMPROMISE OF 1850 WAS A PACKAGE OF LAWS DESIGNED TO ADDRESS THE STATUS OF TERRITORIES ACQUIRED DURING THE MEXICAN-AMERICAN WAR. IT ADMITTED CALIFORNIA AS A FREE STATE, ALLOWED NEW TERRITORIES TO DECIDE ON SLAVERY THROUGH POPULAR SOVEREIGNTY, AND ENACTED A STRICTER FUGITIVE SLAVE ACT. THIS ACT MANDATED THAT ESCAPED ENSLAVED PEOPLE BE RETURNED TO THEIR OWNERS, INCREASING TENSIONS IN THE NORTH AND GALVANIZING ABOLITIONIST RESISTANCE.

THE KANSAS-NEBRASKA ACT

THIS 1854 LAW REPEALED THE MISSOURI COMPROMISE LINE AND ALLOWED SETTLERS IN KANSAS AND NEBRASKA TO DETERMINE SLAVERY'S LEGALITY VIA POPULAR SOVEREIGNTY. THE ACT LED TO VIOLENT CONFRONTATIONS KNOWN AS "BLEEDING KANSAS," HIGHLIGHTING HOW POLITICAL DECISIONS REGARDING SLAVERY COULD IGNITE REGIONAL CONFLICT AND VIOLENCE.

ECONOMIC DIFFERENCES BETWEEN THE NORTH AND SOUTH

NORTHERN INDUSTRIAL ECONOMY

IN CONTRAST, THE NORTH EXPERIENCED RAPID INDUSTRIALIZATION, WITH FACTORIES, RAILROADS, AND URBAN CENTERS DRIVING ECONOMIC GROWTH. WAGE LABOR WAS THE NORM, AND THERE WAS LESS RELIANCE ON SLAVERY, LEADING TO DIVERGENT ECONOMIC INTERESTS THAT INFLUENCED POLITICAL STANCES ON SLAVERY.

ECONOMIC IMPACTS OF THE DIVIDE

DIVISIONS WITHIN WHITE SOCIETY

SLAVERY ALSO CREATED DIVISIONS AMONG WHITE AMERICANS, INCLUDING:

- SOUTHERN WHITES WHO SUPPORTED THE INSTITUTION AS A MEANS OF MAINTAINING SOCIAL HIERARCHY.
- SOME NORTHERN WHITES WHO OPPOSED SLAVERY ON MORAL OR ECONOMIC GROUNDS.

THIS DECISION OUTRAGED ABOLITIONISTS AND INTENSIFIED SECTIONAL TENSIONS BY EFFECTIVELY ALLOWING SLAVERY TO EXPAND UNCHECKED.

JOHN BROWN'S RAID ON HARPERS FERRY

IN 1859, ABOLITIONIST JOHN BROWN LED AN ARMED RAID ON A FEDERAL ARSENAL IN HARPERS FERRY, VIRGINIA, INTENDING TO INCITE A SLAVE REBELLION. ALTHOUGH THE RAID FAILED, IT HEIGHTENED FEARS IN THE SOUTH OF A WIDESPREAD INSURRECTION AND DEEPENED MISTRUST BETWEEN NORTH AND SOUTH.

ELECTION OF ABRAHAM LINCOLN

LINCOLN'S ELECTION IN 1860, ON A PLATFORM OPPOSING THE EXPANSION OF SLAVERY, WAS UNACCEPTABLE TO MANY SOUTHERN STATES. HIS VICTORY PROMPTED THE SECESSION OF MULTIPLE SOUTHERN STATES, DIRECTLY LEADING TO THE OUTBREAK OF THE CIVIL WAR.

THE ROLE OF ABOLITIONISM AND RESISTANCE
