UNDERSTANDING THE TREATMENT OF INJECTING A SOLUTION TO HARDEN THE VEINS

THE SCIENCE BEHIND VEIN HARDENING

THIS TREATMENT INVOLVES THE INTRODUCTION OF A SCLEROSANT, A CHEMICAL AGENT THAT IRRITATES THE ENDOTHELIAL LINING OF THE VEINS. FACTORS INFLUENCING SOLUTION SELECTION

PHYSICIANS CONSIDER SEVERAL FACTORS WHEN SELECTING A SCLEROSANT, INCLUDING:

- VEIN DIAMETER AND DEPTH
- PATIENT SENSITIVITY AND ALLERGY HISTORY
- DESIRED SPEED OF VEIN CLOSURE

LONG-TERM CARE
